Tip: Have someone in your group check your time while you're playing to ensure you are on pace.

Best practice: Pace: 13-14 minutes per hole

To complete 9 Holes

4 some 2 hrs 10 minutes 3 some Less than 2 hours

To complete 18 Holes

4 some 4 hrs 20 minutes 2 some Less than 4 hours

and the hardships we've known


Sometimes we wear them on our sleeves for all to see but often they're hidden as deep as they can be.
