as deep as they can be.*

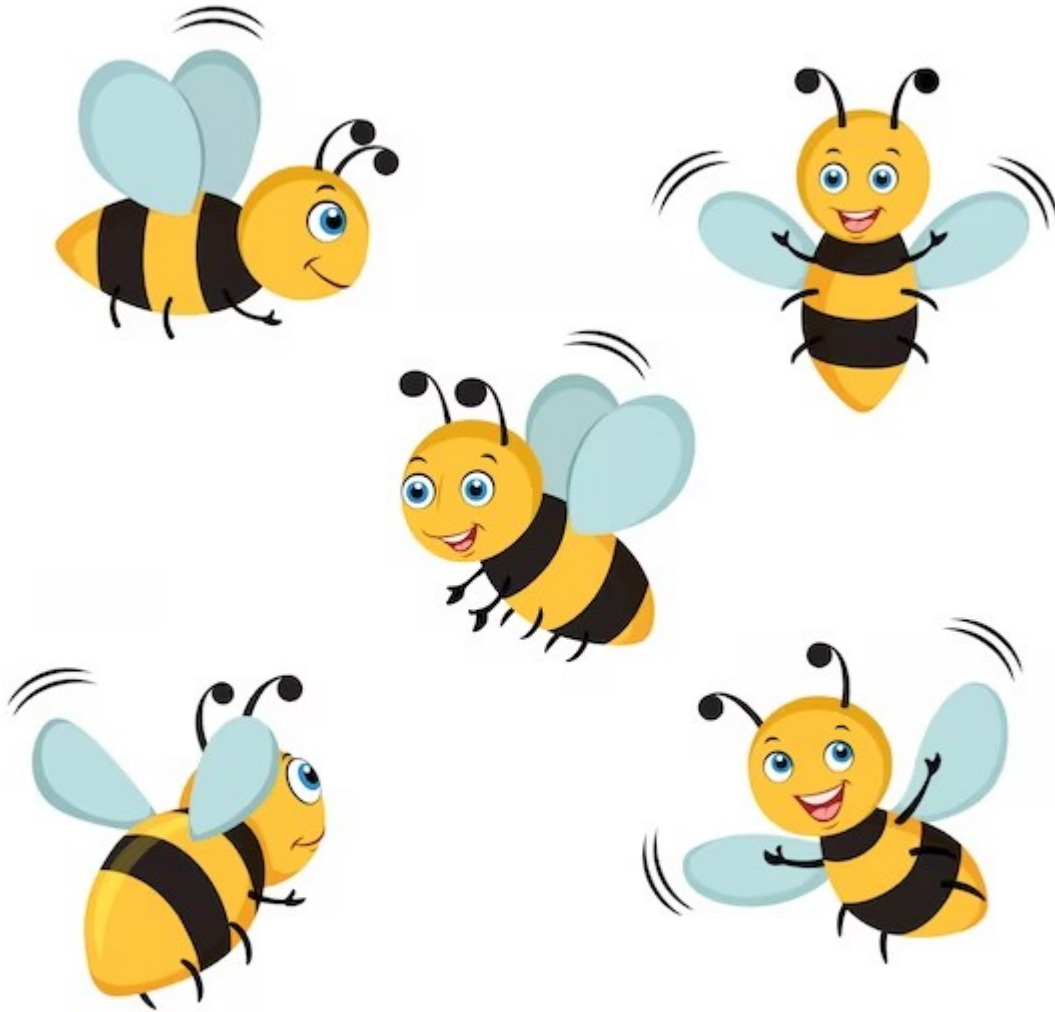
*So, let us be kind
